

How Students Enter Practice Test: Step by Step Directions

- Address: <http://www.fsassessments.org>
- Click on: *Practice Tests* - blue tab on the right-hand side of the page
- Click on: *Take the Computer-Based Practice Tests* tab – first one on left-hand side
- The Student Practice Test Logon Screen will appear
- Leave both “Guest User & Guest Session” Checked”
- Click on: Sign In button – bottom, right-hand side
- Click on: Student Grade Level drop-down box and choose grade level
- Click on: Yes button in the bottom, left-hand corner
- Click on: Test you wish to take (grade level your child is enrolled)
- Student may only change PRINT SIZE & BACKGROUND COLOR CHOICE for actual test. Please DO NOT let them use MASKING OR TEXT TO SPEECH. They are only options for students who have accommodations on a 504 Plan or IEP.
Click on: Select button – blue button – bottom, left-hand corner
- Click on: Yes, Start My Test – bottom, left-hand corner
- Click on: Sound Icon to test sound – IF COMES UP. If hear sound, Click on: Yes – blue button – bottom, left-hand corner
- Review Test Instructions and Help – when done: Click on: Begin Test Now – blue button – bottom, left-hand corner

Tests are NOT graded or recorded. It is just for students to play around with to get comfortable with navigation, help features, buttons, types of questions, and how to respond. Students can take the practice test for each subject offered on their grade level up to 99 times each. Parents can even take the tests as well!!! ENJOY!!

A second, different practice test will be administered by the school at least a week before the scheduled FSA assessment dates to ensure each student has had a chance to become familiar with the format.
