RE: Interpreting Wheel Class Report Card Grades

In order to assign S, N, and U grades in our electronic grade book program, we must associate each letter with a numeric code. This numeric code is not a grade point average. Student who receive an S+, S, or S- from all wheel classes are still eligible for recognition awards such as Super Cub and Honor Rolls. Wheel teachers are using the following numeric codes to assign a grade to your child:

Code 95 = S+ (Satisfactory, Plus)
Code 85 = S (Satisfactory)
Code 75 = S- (Satisfactory, Minus)
Code 65 = N (Needs Improvement)
Code 55 = U (Unsatisfactory)

How to interpret your child's wheel progress report grade:

A *very* few students will receive a:

S+

This means your child is making *exceptional* progress in the class for the nine-weeks.

Most parents will see a:

S

This means your child is making *satisfactory* progress in the class for the nine-weeks.

S-

This means your child is making *adequate* progress, but could be doing better. It would be a good idea to contact the wheel teacher to see what your child could do to make better progress.

N

This means your child needs to improve their progress in the class and you should contact the wheel teacher as soon as possible

U

Your child is *not doing well* in the wheel course and you should contact the wheel teacher as soon as possible.
